For those coming to Mass in Westby

To keep people safe, we have a maximum capacity of 40-50 people, if we reach this you will be asked to stand outside. You could consider coming to Mass during the week.

Do not come if you have a cough, have flu like symptoms, feel unwell :

- * Use hand sanitizer BEFORE and AFTER going to a pew
- * Try to touch as little as possible other than the pew you use
- * Places to sit are marked by Welcome signs. Please fill up from the front of church Households of course may sit together –seating observes the 2 metre spacing rule.
- * Please hold your socially distanced conversations outside in the grounds
- * Holy Communion will be distributed after the final blessing. You are asked to leave the church immediately after receiving Holy Communion
- * Please leave your offertory collection in the baskets at the back of church
- * Leave church doors open
- * Books and leaflets will not be provided if you bring your own, please take them home.
- * Access to the house and sacristy is restricted. Please ask a steward,
- * There are no votive candles due to the risk of fumes from sanitizers igniting on hands
- * The church will be closed after Mass and cleaned
- * Sadly, no coffee after Mass – we have to savor the memory of Sheila's cakes!
