Directions to the Trial Site: From I-4: Take Exit 27 (Polk County Parkway – Highway 570) to the first exit (Airport Road) approximately three miles. Turn right onto Airport Road, go to the second light (Drane Field Road) and turn left. Then stay on Drane Field Road to Century Boulevard, which will be the second street on the left (across from the firehouse station). Turn into the industrial complex, then use the third driveway on the left. The IPOC building is straight ahead.

From Highway 60: Take Highway 60 to S. County Line Road. Go approximately 5 miles to Drane Field Road and turn right. Travel approximately three miles to Century Boulevard and turn left. Then follow the directions above.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for the event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State in entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter al-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
