Clem and Harold Brau – Clem and Harold Brau, from Lucan, Minnesota formed the Clem Brau Orchestra back in 1938 playing many area barn dances and dance halls in and around the Arlington and Redwood Falls area. Clem, Harold, one other brother and sister (Hildegard Brau) formed this orchestra. Their talent probably rubbed off from their parents, Mr. & Mrs. Joseph Brau whom were both musical people. Just before World War II, the orchestra disbanded, and interruption that lasted until 1947 when the Jolly Lumberjacks group was formed. They had two bands: an old-tyme band and a modern band under the same name.
