Ms. Maxwell reported on the recent fire board meeting.

<u>Code Enforcement Report</u> -

Mr. Brown reported on recent zoning permits, notices of violation, and contractor registrations. He is also working with an engineer hired by the new owner of the vacant property to the west side of Rite Aid in regards to zoning requirements and storm drainage.

Mr. John Norton addressed council regarding a notice of violation that was issued on September 15, 2017 for mowing and weeds, and the invoice that was issued by the village on November 24, 2017 for services performed by village personnel to remedy the violation. Mr. Norton described a sequence of events that happened with the person he had charged with mowing the property in his absence and asked that council consider waiving the charges. He also claimed that the property was mowed prior to village employees taking action, and that the village "scalped" the lawn.

Mr. Brown reported that some weed removal was done on one side of the property, however the remainder of the property was still in violation when village personnel took steps to remediate. He added that the street department noted that the mower was set to 5-1/2 inches when mowing. Mr. Brown also provided pictures of the property that was taken prior to mowing. Mayor Reames asked that council take the matter under advisement.

Police Department Report -

Chief Freyhof reported on recent and upcoming trainings for the department to meet their continuing education requirements. He will be attending a program at Clark State Community College in an effort to recruit additional auxiliary and part-time officers.
