Valiant Air Command Commemorates the 75th Anniversary of D-Day

Titusville, Fla. – The media is invited to the Valiant Air Command Warbird Air Museum at the Titusville Airport on June 6, 2019 from 8 AM to Noon to commemorate the 75th anniversary of D-Day, the allied invasion of Europe which turned the tide of the war against Nazi occupation of World War II. Drive-in and Fly-ins are welcome.

The museum's Douglas C-47 Skytrain "Tico Belle," will be on display for tours and photography. The "Tico Belle" flew multiple missions on D-Day delivering two loads of paratroopers and a glider full of troops into Normandy. The plane was active throughout World War II and participated in the Berlin Airlift. On this historic 75th anniversary day the Tico Belle will fly again to honor those who served. Members of the museum's air crew will be on hand for interviews.

The museum will also host World War II veterans from all services for interviews on why the 75th anniversary of D-Day is an important milestone in the preservation of American history.


A special discount admission for adults will be available at the door and visitors will be treated to an "All American Lunch" from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm.
