

Included in the entry fee: An Event Recording Fee of \$0.50 and a \$3.00 Event Service fee will be taken for the first entry of each dog and a \$3.00 Event Service fee for each additional entry of the same dog will be collected. These fees are collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club for all classes.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Trial Hours: For Friday Noon to 4pm. Trial Hours: Saturday and Sunday 8am to 4pm.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian, judge or tester, or barred from competition by the show committee. No refund for duplicate entries. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond control of the judges, or it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- Bitches in season are not eligible to participate in FDC and entry fees will be refunded if a letter from their veterinarian is produced a minimum of 30 minutes before judging starts on Friday
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The trial secretary will assess a collection fee of \$50.00 in addition to the amount of each returned check.
- Closing date: In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 9 of AKC Dog Show Rules, entries will close on said date or when the limit has been reached if prior thereto. Entries must be on the enclosed blank or a reasonable facsimile thereof. Each entry must have the waiver/agreement attached.
- Eligibility: Open to all dogs nine months of age or older. AKC recognized breeds and foundation stock service breed on the AKC website as well as dogs with PAL/ILP numbers may also enter-

Keep the trial site clean. Failure to clean up after your dogs are grounds for excusal from the test.

General Test Information

KENNEL CILIP

- This test is a non-competitive pass/fail evaluation of dog's ability to exhibit self-control in a rural farm setting.
- Open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually recorded with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times unless confined in a crate, kennel, or vehicle.
- Dogs must wear a secure, well fitting, flat collar during the test evaluation
 Handlers can use verbal cues, hand signals, and praise, provided it is not excessive in the opinion of the judges
- Dogs may attempt each test element no more than two times
- Dogs must pass all elements of the test and overall assessment during the same test to qualify
- Dogs must qualify under two different judges in order to be awarded the FDC suffix title.
- The judge may discontinue testing if he/she determines the dog is too fearful or under duress to perform the required elements
- The judge may request the removal of any dog from the immediate test area at any time, if he/she determines the presence of a dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs, or persons on the farm.
