

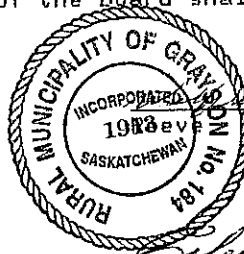
RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GRAYSON NO. 184

BYLAW NO. 1-1997

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A RECREATION BOARD

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. There shall be appointed by the Council a Recreation Board which shall be known as the Crooked Lake Parks and Recreation Board.
2. The function of the board shall be: to develop, manage and operate recreational programs.
3. Such a board shall consist of nine (9) members, appointed by the residents of Crooked Lake and surrounding district.
4. At the first appointment of the board members, the term of office shall be one year.
5. At the expiration of the term of any appointed member of the Board, the Board shall appoint a person to take his or her place as a member of the Board.
6. Every member of the Board shall hold office until his successor is appointed.
7. If any member of the Board absents himself for the meetings of the Board for a period of 3 consecutive regular meetings, unless excused by resolution of such Board in session, or his seat becomes vacant by death, resignation or otherwise, then on being notified by the Board that such a seat has become vacant, the Board shall forthwith appoint or re-appoint a person to fill such vacancy for the remainder of the term.
8. The Chairman and Secretary Treasurer of the Board shall be elected by the Board and shall hold office until a successor is elected. The Chairman shall have the right to vote.
9. All orders and proceedings of the Board shall be entered in the books to be kept for that purpose and be signed by the Chairman or Secretary Treasurer.
10. The first Board shall be appointed by the residents of Crooked Lake and surrounding district. After the passing of the by-law, the Board at its first meeting shall set the date for their regular meetings. The Board may hold special meetings at the call of the Chairman.
11. Six (6) members of the Board shall constitute a quorum.
