## Highway Superintendent Report:

We continue to cold patch, cleaning the trucks, all of the clips are off and tarps on. We have been working on ditching and hauled blacktop for several Towns. Truck 206, we have spent a lot of money into the transmission, it has had a lot of codes. The transmission is new and we have about \$25,000 into this truck this year. We will talk to them about the labor cost. We have been going around with Spectrum, on centerline by Bide a Bit, there were putting in poles on the right of way. Heard from the State, on the winter recovery and it is still questioning how things will work out. CHIPS – I will work with the CHIPS money and not the winter recover. Working on roads, did 6 miles of sealing, Hollow, Buffalo, Standish to Exchange. Shimmed Weber and Standish. The Battery project, extended the permit for 120 days, they are writing grants, and he assured that the Engineer will be out to check. Reisdorf, from the Batavia office is saying that we owe them \$14,000. We went through all of the payments a few years ago, and we were ok. Supervisor May to contact them.

<u>Town Clerk Report:</u> Our Town website visits for April was 1504 and May was 1619. The Towns total revenue for the month of May 2020 was \$507.00, \$387.00 for dog licenses, \$50.00 for Registrar and \$70.00 for zoning fees. We had 14 dog renewal licenses and 8 new license. To the general fund, \$240.00, Dogs were 120.00, \$70.00 for zoning, and \$50.00 for registrar. We disbursed \$180.00 to Wyoming County, \$50.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs. The link information on our website regarding Spectrum, is still not currently working.

Correspondence: No new correspondence.

Supervisor May explained to the Board the Mr. DiMatteo asked if the Board would have him attempt to recover the \$765.75 that it cost the Town in having Mr. Elhage fulfill the ZBA requirements. Supervisor May will check on what it will cost the Town to complete this action, the Board is in favor of recouping monies spent.

Mr. Ahl asked that the Town Clerk assure that the cemetery funds will be prepared for July's meeting.

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the 2020 Highway Fund Bills: Abstract #6 Vouchers #79 through 92 through totaling \$24,855.92. A motion was made by Mr. Boxler, seconded by Mr. Herman to approve the payment of the Highway Fund bills.
