## Civic Report

**Election Results** 

This year's election was a record turnout nationally, which is a great success for democracy.

In San Mateo we saw a turnout of 85%. Currently there are  $\sim$ 2,300 ballots left to count. This has been slower this year because of the high number of mailed ballots.

Ballots Cast 376,027 Vote Center Ballots 31,782 Vote by Mail Ballots 344,245 Registered Voters 442,637

Nationally 66.4% - 72.1% of 239,247,182 eligible voters voted.

While Measure R has failed, Measure Y is still too close to call at this time. Passage of Measure RR means an increase in sales tax to support Caltrain, and passage of Measure T will mean a ~\$400 tax burden on your property tax.

\*\*Important\*\* Senior Homeowners (65+) can contact the School District directly to request an application and sign up for an exemption from this tax (this is the number to call: 650-312-7269). Measure W imposes an increased transient occupancy tax.

NEW CITY ORDINANCE- Sewer Lateral Inspection Requirement The city passed a new ordinance this year that goes into effect on December 1st. It requires homeowners to have their sewer lines inspected when A) they are selling their home or B) they are completing \$90k+ in home improvements. There are more details to this program at www.cityofsanmateo.org/PSLO. The city did send out a brochure recently and I encourage you to review it if you might fall into either of those categories.

In addition, the city has a cost sharing program for full sewer line replacements. If you are going to be remodeling or selling your home, you may want to consider doing this earlier so that you can get help with the costs. The city is paying up to 50% or \$5000 whichever is lower toward the replacement. For more information, visit www.cityofsanmateo.org/1910.
