Bring your non-perishable items and come down and let's fill the truck.

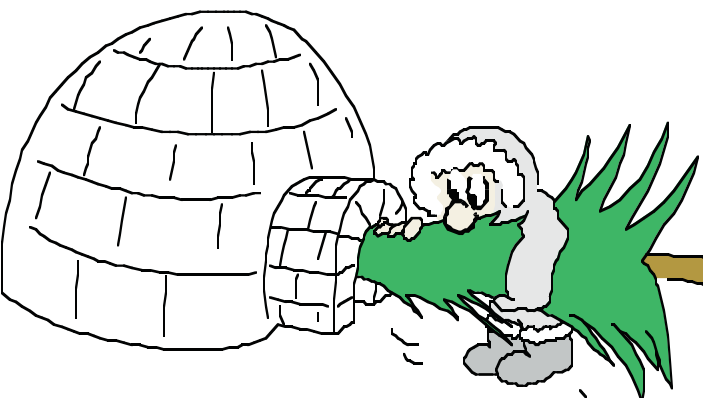
