
The ride home on Sunday was very pleasant with temperatures starting out in the 70s and around 83 degrees when we reached home. A very pleasant ride!

Sharing the Highway with Semi-Trucks

Several years ago, I was at a safety seminar concerning the blind spots of a semi-truck. We had the opportunity to sit in the driver's seat of a semi-truck to observe the "blind spots" of the road to promote safety when riding a motorcycle near a semi-truck. Even though there were bikes parked beside and behind the truck, when one sat in the driver's seat, the bikes disappeared.

By learning about blind spots, stopping distances and other important truck specific safety tips motorcyclists can improve their chances of being seen and reduce the number of highway deaths. Because of their smaller size and ability to move quickly in and out of traffic, motorcycles create a special challenge for the professional truck driver. By working together with motorcyclists and promoting awareness we can make the road more enjoyable for all vehicles.

KEY POINTS:

- **Never cut in front of a truck.** Fully loaded trucks can weigh up to 80,000 pounds and take the length of a football field to stop.
- **Don't linger alongside a truck**. There are large blind spots on all four sides of a truck. Front, back and both sides. With the largest blind spot on the right. If a tire should blow, a rubber chunk that weighs as much as 100 pounds could come flying out and wipe out a cyclist.
- Where possible, avoid passing on the right side. The right blind spot runs the length of the truck and extends out three lanes.

TIPS:

- At 65 mph you're covering almost 100 feet per second. Space is time, and time saves lives.
- When riding behind a truck, maintain at least a 4 second following distance. Stay far enough back so that you can see the driver in the mirrors; or any debris that may be in the road. Following too close obstructs your view of the road ahead and leaves you no time to react to emergencies.
- Look for the driver in the mirror before you begin to pass. Then **move quickly past** the truck and only pull back in front once a **safety cushion** is established. If you have **other bikes following you** continue **the extra speed before you pull back in.** Do not pull back in front of the truck and resume your cruising speed **leaving no space for others to safely pull in front of the truck.**
- When passing, never linger along the side of a truck. Due to the size and speed of today's bikes, it's easy for riders to quickly move into blind spots and become invisible to the driver.
- When riding as a group in a stagger pattern, it is safest to pass the truck in single file, staying to the far side of the lane.
- Also, when passing be aware of strong crosswinds or air turbulence coming off the truck. These winds could be strong enough to push you out of your lane.

Many new trucks have an automatic braking system that takes over control of the semi when a vehicle cuts too closely in front of the truck. This system overrides the driver and slows the truck with engine braking and/ or brakes. What does this mean to us as motorcyclists? It means that we need to be extra cautious as we ride up behind a semi, as it could suddenly slow down, perhaps rather quickly. Do not tail-gate a semi (even in a car) as it could lead to an emergency stop situation that **could catch you and those behind you by surprise**.


