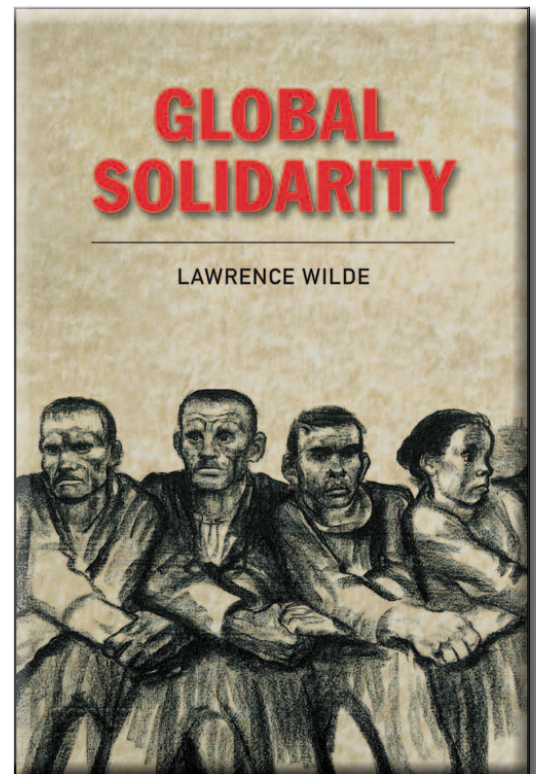
Explores the potential of globalisation to provide the conditions for a harmonious global community
