Why Bergen Stables?

THE HORSE ALWAYS COMES FIRST! We breed our own from our broodmares so there is never any mark-up on a horse. We give the horse to the partnership - proving we are in it to win it! Bergen Stables will have shares in the partnership and receive all NY Breeder Awards, Bergen Stables charges no commission or management fees. Bergen Stables only earns money when you do!

All partnerships will be a registered LLC in the name of the horse. Quarterly expense and account balance reports will be provided to all partners.

We encourage all partners to become involved, including visiting with your horse. Bergen Stables will make most of the day to day decisions and will always have final say in regards to the horses health, safety and well-being. We welcome input from the partners who will be asked to vote on race entries, minor care, as well as if and when to sell or retire the horse.

Partners wishing to obtain an owners license, which could be required depending on your percentage of ownership, will receive our assistance in obtaining your owners license.

Bergen Stables will automatically donate 1% of any and all winnings received by the partnership to a thoroughbred retirement.

The feeling of breeding and raising a foal to become a racehorse and stand with your horse in the Winner's Circle is overwhelming. The goal of Bergen Stables is to involve more fans in this exhilarating sport and witness the performance of these magnificent athletes!

Why New York Bred?

New York Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund Corporation administers an awards and incentives program for thoroughbreds foaled in New York and who race on New York tracks. The program was developed in 1973.

There are over 67 stakes races scheduled annually by the New York Racing Association and Finger Lakes Racing Association exclusively for a registered New York bred. In addition, there are

over 800 races written each year in the state covering a wide range of conditions for a registered New York bred.

Where will my horse be stabled?

From the time your horse is foaled until the summer of it's yearling year, it will be on a farm in Gardiner, NY where your horse will receive the superb care needed for early development.

When your horse is a yearling, it will go to Ghent, NY toward the end of the year for "basic training" camp. Your horse will learn to jog, gallop, and handle the gate, as well as develop mentally and physically into a racehorse.

In the winter, your horse will return home for break. and in the spring of your horse's two year old year, it will return to the training center until the beginning of summer.

After returning home for a very short break, your horse is paired with a trainer. The trainer will then begin working with your horse at a racetrack, where it will be stabled in preparation of it's first race. Your horse will continue with the trainer for the life of it's racing career.

If and when the horse needs a lay-up due to injury or just needing a rest, it will return to Gardiner, NY.

When Is The Return On My Investment?

The emotional and therapeutic return from bonding with you horse is immediate!

The feeling of pride and accomplishment from starting with your horse as a foal to seeing him go through the starting gate when it springs open can't be matched!

When your horse wins a race, purse earnings are deposited into the partnership account and distributed - less any expenses.

If the horse is entered into a claiming race by a vote of the partners and is claimed, all money in the account will then be distributed accordingly - less any expenses. This will end the partnership.

If the horse is sold through a partnership vote, all money in the account will be distributed accordingly - less any expenses. This will end the partnership.

Should the partnership be fortunate enough to have a stakes quality male horse, which is a colt or horse, the opportunity to have a stallion may exist. We cannot speculate on value but there is the possibility that it could equal winning a lottery!

Should the partnership be fortunate enough to have a stakes quality female horse, which is a filly or a mare, the opportunity to have a broodmare may exist. We can then sell or race her progeny, which is offspring, for many years to come!

What happens when my horse is injured?

If an injury occurs, the situation is evaluated and sometimes hard decisions will need to be made. Partners will be informed about the situation and asked for their input. The final rule will always be made as to what is in the best interest for your horse regarding it's health and well being. The athlete, not the partnership, will always come first regarding an injury.

What happens when my horse is retired?

Your horse's racing career could end due to an injury or because it is no longer competitive and it would be in your horse's best interest to retire. If your horse is not able to be a stallion or a broodmare, it will be placed on a thoroughbred retirement farm. A partner could also ask to have the horse as a companion but is only possible if Bergen Stables approves that partner has the proper means to care for and stable the horse.

What If I Want To Sell My Interest In The Partnership?

You can sell, gift and will your partnership interest providing that person signs a continuing agreement and must abide by all partnership rules and conduct.

Bergen Stables, not the partnership, will always take back any horse that the partnership sells, retires or gives away if it can no longer be properly cared for.

What Is Covered In My Initial Investment?

Your ownership investment covers registration fees, ordinary vet and farrier fees, boarding, feed and vitamins, grooming and dental, training, accounting, advertising and social media until January 1st (the birthday of thoroughbreds in the Northern Hemisphere) of your horse's 3 year old year. Illness or injury is not included because it is an unexpected expense.

There exist no mark-up on the above expenses. Bergen Stables believes this will give partners a better opportunity for a positive return on their investment with us than with any other thoroughbred racing partnership in existence.

What Are The Ongoing Expenses After My Horse turns 3?

The idea is to have your horse earn his own keep so there are no expenses but hopefully a surplus. If this does not happen due to your horse being injured, not coming in the money, requiring layup, extra training or any other reason, the partnership needs to cover expenses. Each partner would be responsible for their portion of expenses according to the shares owned.

What Establishes Value Of A Yearling Going To Partnership?

Bergen Stables uses all costs included in your initial investment, the cost to care for the broodmare while in foal (approximately 11 months), the actual foaling and foal care costs and the stallion's stud fee (if any) to figure the valuation.

3rd Dam, ZALATAIA (FR) by DICTUS (FR.), a Grade One and Multiple Graded Stakes winner in the USA and France, earning \$561,168 during a 23-race career. She is the dam of the Breeders' Cup Turf Winner, FRAISE, who had three Grade One wins earning \$2,613,105 and set track records at Saratoga and Gulfstream Park. ZALATAIA produced 10 foals, 8 runners, 5 winners, and a Grade One Stakes winner, earning \$2,926,348 on the race track.

Why Bergen Stables Instead Of Other Racing Partnerships?

Bergen Stables has their own band of broodmares we breed to. We select a sound, well conformed horse from the annually produced "stock" to give the race partnership. This allows us to keep your initial costs low because we do not purchase the horses, whether privately or at auction, and then sell them back with a mark-up attached.

If and when expenses, such as vet, board, etc., need to be paid for, there are no mark-ups applied to the costs - you get to see the actual bill.

Bergen Stables will never charge a commission! Having a \$100,000 investment purchase claimed away for \$25,000 should not reward the stable with 10% percent commission.

Management fees can also add up to a hefty sum so we don't charge them! These fees are usually charged monthly along with a percentage of purse earnings. This will keep them from paying any expenses in the partnership.

When your horse is not earning, then you are not earning! Keeping a non-competitive horse on the payroll can be quite costly. All partners will be involved in voting on race entries, if and when to geld (if you have a colt), sell and retire the racehorse.

Bergen Stables believes in fairness and wants to breathe new life into this thrilling sport.
