

# Morgan Hill Community Garden Fall Check-up!!!

1. **Have I removed my old plants?**

Cut down plants and leave the roots in the ground.  
Chop plant waste into small pieces.  
Leave the cuttings on top of the soil as mulch.  
If the cuttings need to go in the compost pile or yard waste bins, they must be cut into small pieces first.



2. **Plant winter seeds and transplants NOW while the soil and weather are still warm!!**

Have I decided which fall/winter crops I want to plant and maintain over the winter months? Planting ideas for the month and a year-long planting guide are posted on the bulletin board at the garden by the shade structure.

3. Remember that **gardening at the MHCG is organic** when working the soil and tending new plants. Keep weeds down by pulling weeds regularly all year and mulching on top of the soil.

4. **Do I have the November 14 Potluck and Election on my calendar?**

Come and socialize with other gardeners. Enjoy the delicious food. Bring something to share! Details are in a previous email and posted at the Garden. Read the email from the garden about elections for voting alternatives if attending on November 14 doesn't work in your schedule.
