HIPPA Notice

I am required by law to protect the privacy of your protected health information. All information I collect from you will be kept confidential, with the exception of the items listed below.

How your health information is used

- 1. I may collaborate with your other medical and psychiatric providers so that I can provide you the best medical care.
- 2. I will need to share some of your healthcare information (such as dates of treatment, services provided, diagnoses, progress in treatment, etc) with your insurance company in order to bill and receive payment for services provided.
- Under certain circumstances, I am required by law to share information without your consent.
 These situations include if I suspect child or elder abuse or if I suspect another person may be in imminent danger.
- 4. Parents or legal guardians of minor clients have the right to access the clients' records.
- 5. If you have give written authorization to share your health information with others, including schools.

Your health information rights

- 1. You may review and get a paper copy of your medical records.
- 2. You may receive a copy of my privacy policies.
- 3. You may receive an accounting of when your information was shared without your consent.
- 4. You may request in writing that your health information to be shared with others. You may also opt at any time not to have your health information shared with others.
