## The Walter H. Scott Memorial Scholarship Fund

Purpose:	The WHSMSF awards annual financial scholarships to college-bound high school student-athletes based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an express interest in obtaining higher education.
Criteria:	The student-athletes eligible for assistance must be a graduating high school student-athlete of Troup County Schools who has lettered at least one year in one sport and maintained a 2.5 simple grade point average. In addition, student-athletes must continue their education at a four- year college or university. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need, and the student's community service record.
Guidelines:	Scholarship recipients will be notified by Monday, May 10, 2021. Funds will be disbursed on Tuesday, June 1, 2021. Student-athletes must be enrolled in a college or university.
Amount:	The scholarship awarded will be a minimum of \$500.
Deadline:	The application deadline is Friday, April 16, 2021. The deadline is the date which applications will no longer be accepted. The selection committee will use the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.
