**Monthly Fiscal Report-** We are now 58.3% into this fiscal year and have revenues of about 53% while our expenditures are up to 57.5%. This is in part due to the colder weather, utility bills and our responses to various weather events.

Our tax collections for the third quarter are due on Feb. 17<sup>th</sup>. Any mailed payments postmarked Feb. 17<sup>th</sup> will be processed on the 18<sup>th</sup> due to the holiday without any penalty.

**Time Warner Cable-**The Town and we presume subscribers received or will receive notices related to the Cable company's fee schedule beginning next month. This includes their standard TV pkg which will go from \$76.49 to \$78.99 next month. They are also notifying customers that on or about March 7, 2014 they will be making technical changes to their system and it may require a subscriber to perform a new channel scan IF your TV has the menu for this. Customers using digital cable set top boxes should not notice any change.

**Municipal Revenue Sharing Testimony-**On January 22, over 100 communities provided testimony to the Joint Committee of Finance and Appropriations regarding the funding for Municipal Revenue Sharing. Bridgton's testimony was entered into the record around 12:20 PM in favor of its funding. We are now seeing efforts on the part of legislators to provide funding though it is split along party lines.
