Thankyou Holy Spirit for your good purpose to glorify our Lord Jesus.

This past Sunday we attended a lunch talk in regards to a youth center located in Blackfalds a town of about 12,000 15 minutes north of where we live. In the early 90's I (Will) was nudged to a similar task by Holy Spirit. I in the main (with Angelic help at times I am sure!) renovated a decrepit curling rink (check Utube as to what curling is.) I committed to and spent a full year operating the youth center. Several of the boys who were it seemed the primary target for the center, have now died from drugs or killed in shady circumstances or in jail. Many stories... So, my heart touched as I listened to Ben share what they were doing and when it came to funding ... his concerns with how to share the needs. 2 Cor 9:7 as in his heart , not reluctantly or under compulsion...It was interesting as so many of the thoughts he evidenced were the ones I struggle with every newsletter written. How to present the needs (especially many years ago, when we had so many babies, but even VERY IMPORTANT now as those babies now are making up the main of the 70 or so children we still care for). It seemed enough to share the stories of these tiny treasures brought to us because moms died and dad's heart strickened with bringing their babies to strangers (usually after relatives trying to feed them everything but what was needed as the mom's milk was not there.) So, hindered by my judgements of many years (PREVIOUS TO 2003) of watching television pleas for funds to help save little babies with sad tear stained, flies crawling, bellies extended and rags for clothing and the offers of caring for this child only 78 cents a day and givers to receive a picture every year and letters from their child. For us the added long-term cost of staff, advertising, facilitating all the steps needed to provide the giver with the feeling of having their own orphan child in where ever ... doesn't seem to be the way most Tiyamike partners would want to see their funds used? Maybe it is necessary as an encouragement for some people to give and continue giving as it ties (at least on their part even if not the child) them into the life time of the child? It's not wrong to want to be appreciated for helping. The promise we are given is better than anything in this world: Matt 6:19-21 ... But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. Your help is so appreciated!

Holy Spirit's involvement seems to us at times not evident (and yet??) by the ongoing immediate need for funds: now the first time unable to repay friends loans (1,500 USD), catch up overdue payments for pensions, and taxes, immediate need of maize and vegetables and fish cooking oil and all the needs of a kitchen feeding 100 plus people each meal, firewood (growing scarcer each month) with costs going up, blankets as washed threadbare are no longer helping.. as now in Malawi winter, slippers/crocs for all as theirs are worn thru, so many items written of many times ... all needed for 70 children. Cleaning supplies, soap for body and clothes, floor disinfectants and bleach, dish soap, the full list is available... new mattress covers for the worn out, maintenance and repairs put off, electrical wire and supplies to light up our Corner house for boys (these are in addition to our boys at the TMC 3 location) new septic system improvements, maintenance and plumbing issues, funds for garden development, School fees and all costs associated coming in September, fuel for generator, switch over costs for going to gas cooking from firewood (we have two very good new burner assemblies). With the devaluation last November of 44% there seems little rhyme or reason for the costs as any excuse always brings increases to come and as a rule stay. The need is great both immediate and long-term please get wild n crazy "consider" helping with the caveat of "Unless he tells you not to." For those who have been able to help, please keep doing what you have peace to do. Your gifts have been and remain so crucial. For those who have been frustrated with no phone app way to give, we cannot say when but our hope is within 2024. Earlier this week while sending funds to Tiyamike there were Bank IT problems. I happened to open an email from our manager Mike mentioning finding an extra MK7,000,000 in the Tiyamike account. I remembered difficulty transferring funds last Friday with kickbacks and pop ups saying invalid this and that... the result was somehow MK10,500,000 was sent as if from our account (a different bank in Blantyre without an extra 7,000,000 in it) ... At first the thought was it must be a bank error (correct thinking) as it should have been MK 3,500,000 (about MK 5,000,000 short of what was sorely needed...) I had sent clear word the 7 million is not ours ... but not seeing text from me Mike and Bello decided perhaps I was trying to surprise them with three times what I had said I was able to forward to use for needs. What are the odds I contact them regarding the Bank error at the same time they were submitting a check to withdraw 2 million from the 7 million??? Thankfully they were able to stop the withdrawal (saving the need to redeposit it) Such timing is not conceivable in my regular thinking however not at all a surprise in Holy Spirit's going before. So repeated thumb prints "I am with you and have not forgotten Tiyamike" So now towards the end of this letter As you decide in your heart and without compulsion do whatever it is your sense to do. We truly realize the pressures of these times. Pam and I thankfully have our pensions for support and wonder-full dear friends supported us not a few different times even to covering full medical costs (12,000 CAD plus) beyond our Alberta Govt benefits (over the year of 2023) within \$9.11 difference with erratic costs and spontaneous (uncommunicated needs) gifts. I do fear that for too long, I have not been timely enough and clear enough in regards to the serious needs we have for Tiyamike...am I living too much in the hope Holy Spirit is touching hearts when he has given me gifts of writing to do so?? ... I sincerely apologize With the great difficulties and relatedly preparation of budgets and then having to continually cut back every where we can to keep food in place and too often only a portion of staff wages ... caught up within the month for the most part each time, but causing grief with our treasured staff as they often borrow at 20% per month repayment when they are without food. I sadly have had a pride in Tiyamike always being provided for over the years and out of that resisting sharing needs and difficulties as much as I believe I should be. surrender that pride and remain a fool for Jesus in every part of my being that I know of with permission given to have all that I am to our Lord's Kingdom purpose. Pam and I are in agreement for all and every part of who we are "to be surrendered" to the point (process) of welcoming the Altar which means dead to self ...



needed much... as dead people do not crawl off the Altar of surrender - His plans not ours. Romans 8: 9-17, then: John 5:19 "does what he sees Father doing", and: John 12:49-50 "says what the Father has told him to say" and: Is 1 John 4:17 true?: "... because as he is so also are we in this world."
