DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing George Birnie designed recurve. Marblewood riser. The riser is in excellent condition. The limbs show considerable wear and tear. To be safe, I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 20 hours) to make sure the glues still held and no stress cracks developed. I then shot the bow several times. Despite the wear and tear to the limbs, this bow performs well. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing. A few minor scratches, nicks and blemishes here and there. Decal is a reproduction. Overall, this is a serviceable hunting bow that shoots really well. Comes with a new string and the old camo limb socks shown on the last page.
