

SSSAA TRACK AND FIELD REPORT

1967.

The ninth annual Track and Field Meet of SSSAA was held on Mon 8 May 67 and Tues 9 May 67. Mon the events were held during a steady drizzle, and Tues was a cold, windy day.

Northern and Central tied for the J. E. Johnston Junior Boy's Trophy with 63 Points.

The Individual Junior Championship was a three-way tie between Dean Hammil of Northern, Ron Falik of Central, and Bob Heartwell of Central. These boys had 13 points each.

The W. Rogers Intermediate Boy's Trophy was won by Northern with 71 points.

Tom Walker of St. Clair was the Intermediate Champion with 16 points.

Northern with 103 points won the SCITS Key Club Trophy for Senior Boys.

Brent Mc Farlane of SCITS won the Senior Championship with 16 points.

Four records were established and one tied in a heat.

Sarnia Athletes competed in WOSSA on Sat 20 May 67 at London and Northern CI & VS won the Intermediate Championship.

Joel Thomas of Northern tied for the Intermediate Individual WOSSA title.

Several Sarnia athletes competed in OFSAA on Sat 27 May in Hamilton. Mike Withers had a first in the Javelin.

The new 6-4-3-2-1 scoring system was used in the SSSAA Meet for the first time and seemed to work satisfactorily.

Suggestions for 1968 include the changing of the times of the Javelin and Discus throws.

Many thanks to the athletes, coaches and officials who made this year's Meet such a great success.
