Volunteer Eligibility Guidelines

The volunteer program is designed to educate and raise awareness for organizations that are serving the LGBT community. As you log hours with each of our community partners you will be eligible for payments to be sent to your preexisting student loans.

To be eligible for the program the following criteria must be met:

- You must have a student loan balance.
- You must be able to fulfill the 50 hour minimum with one or each of our community partners.
- You must identify as LGBT or an Ally.

For the student loan payment program certain restrictions apply and is only active while funds are available.

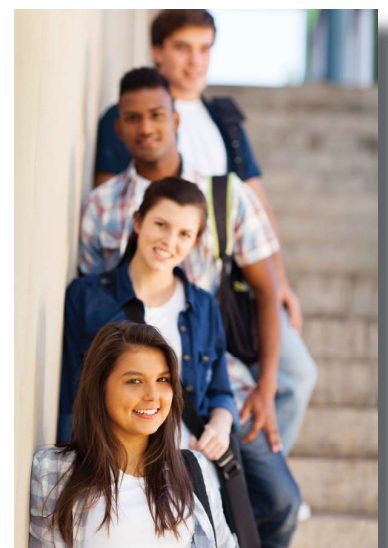
