Communication



We believe that communication is vital in the effective running of our school. We do this in a variety of ways-

- Most importantly, wherever possible, we like to give messages/share good news/ concerns/support face to face!
- The SLT are visible – at the back gate/front gate/ middle unit playground daily
- We have a text message service so that important information and reminders are sent
- We have Twitter to share good news:-)
- Parents invited weekly to our “Golden Certificate” Award ceremony
- Our website gives information about all aspects of the school
- Regular newsletters for each year group and from the Head teacher termly
- Notes home/phone calls if a concern or injury raised by the midday supervisors/staff
- Communication book between teachers and midday supervisors
- Confidential meetings share any key information so that all have the same approach when dealing with a vulnerable child
- Effective transition between year groups – meeting one to discuss pupil attainment and progress and meeting two to discuss social aspect. Children have transition to new class and playground.
- Updated information shared with stakeholders
- Effective communication links and transition with our secondary schools and local nurseries
- Effective communication between the staff – working together as a team and spotting challenges early or sharing successes
- We refer quickly to a variety of agencies to support all of our families
- Quick intervention and discussion with parents if attendance/pupil progress is flagged up
