I want to mention something to everyone that is going to be happening on 3 June. IBC will celebrate our 10th Anniversary on that Sunday. Immediately after the service, we will have lunch in our Fellowship Hall and it will be a time of reflecting on these first ten years. Feel free to invite those former members who might have moved away but would like to come back for this special Sunday.

Today we continue to look at the Books of the Minor Prophets with a focus on the Book of Haggai. This is a book about priorities. With Haggai, we now have a shift in the history as these final three books were written after the return of the exiles to Jerusalem. In fact, we know the exact date of its writing, which was over a four-month period beginning on 29 August 520 BC. One of their immediate tasks was to rebuild Solomon's Temple, and initially the pace was fast and furious. Unfortunately, they soon had to deal with opposition which led to the rebuilding being stopped for about fifteen years. Without the Temple, the people could not properly worship the Lord. As a result, God sent Haggai to challenge the people to rearrange their priorities and finish what they had started.

We are thrilled to have you here with us as we worship our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
