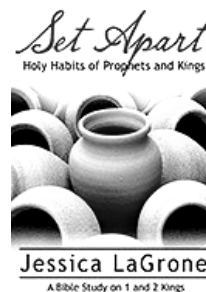

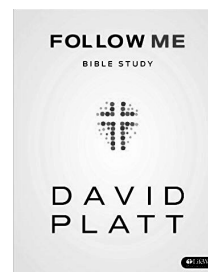
Set Apart— Jessica LaGrone
