SECTION A - QUAD RODEO

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per rider for Battery powered class

\$10.00 per Gas Class per rider

A rider may register more than one quad. Multiple riders may register the same quad.

IF SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS ARE REQUIRED THEY MUST BE MADE KNOWN AT REGISTRATION!

1. Upon arrival each rider must register and sign a "Liability Waiver/Release Form". Any rider under age 18 must have parent/guardian signature.
2. All competitors must attend the riders meeting prior to event.
3. Riders must wear a helmet and riding/work boot. Eye protection and gloves are recommended.
4. Operators only.....No passengers, this includes the side by side class.
5. Quad must be mechanically sound. Anything deemed unsafe by the officials will result in the quad not being able to compete.
6. All quads and equipment must remain in the pit area. No one is permitted to ride on the rounds except in designated areas. Any breaking of these rules will result in an automatic disqualification and removal from event, and there are **NO REFUNDS!**
7. Officials may alter rules or the course of the event as deemed necessary.
8. Official's decisions are final.
9. **NO 3 WHEELERS PERMITTED**
10. In the battery operated classes a parent or guardian maybe present in the arena. All other classes rider is on their own.

4. Only animals entered the entire week of the fair may compete.

1. All Participants must register by June 15th on general entry form. Indicate on the entry form as to whether the bale is to be placed on its side or standing on end.
2. Round bales will be provided and placed in outdoor locations. Participants must check-in at the Fair Office for the location of their bale.
3. Participants must provide their own decorating supplies.
4. No mechanical, electrical or electronic devices maybe used.
5. All entries must be completed no later than 12:00 pm on first Saturday of fair.

Rules: (In addition to the General Rules)

1. Stock battery may be replaced with a 12-volt lawn mower battery only. May be placed under hood and secured. You may cut out some of the engine bay to fit the battery.
 2. Secure hood and doors so they do not come open. No quads or gators. It must have something protecting legs. It must be a vehicle-type power wheels.
 3. Must have some type of seatbelt.
 4. Must wear a helmet.
 5. May have a rollover bar made from plastic pipe.
 6. Must be completely stock, no modifying of anything, only what is stated!!!!
 7. No lowering or raising of front or rear.
 8. Ages 4 to 10 years old.
 9. 15-minute time limit.
 10. All entries must be completed no later than 5:00 pm
- This is to be a fun event for the kids!

Rules:

1. This is a timed event, based on skill and agility of task at hand on a skid loader/skid steer on closed course.
2. Time limit will be announced depending on participation of event.
3. Participants will be disqualified if,
 - A. Item is carried.
 - B. Any boundary line is crossed.
 - C. Any action is deemed unsafe.
 - D. Participant takes longer than allotted time.
4. Participant may be able to get comfortable with controls and machine at officials discretion before starting competition.
5. Time starts once start line is crossed and stops at completion of task.
6. Event may be canceled due to inclement weather.
7. Decision of officials are final.
8. Seatbelt must be worn, and engine must be shutoff when dismounting.
9. Any discrepancies must be submitted in writing at time of discrepancy.
10. Entries will be taken from 1 hour before event to completion of class.

PA Preferred™ Strength in Our Diversity 2018 YOUTH POSTER CONTEST

CRITERIA FOR THE STATE CONTEST

The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture will once again conduct a statewide youth poster contest at the agricultural fairs. Participating fairs hold their own contest and submit one poster from each age group to the state level for additional judging and cash prizes. Winning posters will be displayed at the 2019 Pennsylvania Farm Show.

1. Only one poster may be submitted per exhibitor, per age group. There will be three state competitions: ages 8-11, 12-14, and 15-18. Exhibitors must be in one of these age groups as of June 1 of the current fair season to qualify.
2. The poster size must be either 14 x 22 inches or 14 ½ x 22 inches. Other sizes will not be accepted for judging at the state level.
3. This year's theme is **Strength in Our Diversity**. Contestants are asked to submit artwork that showcases and celebrates the people, products, production practices, and traditions of Pennsylvania's agriculture industry. Exhibitors using other themes will be disqualified at the state level.
4. Only one poster per age group per fair may be forwarded for the state competition. The fair secretary or contest coordinator is responsible for submitting the poster and completing the entry form for each poster with each age group. **The poster and contest entry form can be given to the Fair Fund Administrator at the PSACF fall zone meetings or mailed to:**

5. Posters must be packaged flat. Posters rolled or folded will not be eligible for judging.
6. Posters must be received or post marked by **November 1, 2018**.
7. Posters will be evaluated on use of the theme, visual appearance and creativity in relation to the exhibitor's age.
8. Premium checks for:

- 1st place \$100
- 2nd place \$75
- 3rd place \$50

These checks will be presented by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each age category. Winners will be notified in advance and invited to attend an awards presentation to be held during the 2019 Pennsylvania Farm Show. They will also be required to provide their social security numbers for award disbursements. All posters will become the property of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture for possible future promotional activities for the Pennsylvania Farm Show and Pennsylvania State Association of County Fairs. Any duplication of posters from previous years will be disqualified. Posters will not be returned.
