Pg 7 Section 111.Homesite Owner's Rights



B: No motor vehicle which cannot operate on its own power shall remain in The Meadows property for more than 24 hours, and no repair on any motor vehicle shall be made on the Meadows property.

Only vehicle washing and waxing in Meadow's driveways is allowed. If you want to do an oil change or other repair yourself, you are required to park the vehicle completely inside the garage to perform the repairs. If your vehicle needs extensive any other work take your vehicle to a repair shop or your car dealership.
