Relax, finish homework, hang out with your friends...whatever. YAS is a place for you to spend time, however you like, after the school day. Orleans Community Partnership (OCP) has made all three rooms available – and it's an easy walking distance to the library and NRMS. We'll have a quiet space for homework help, available computers, and scheduled activities that you can participate in...if you want. Let your parents know that supervision will be provided by experienced, CORI'd program leaders who are committed to making YAS a 'drop-in' space that you'll enjoy and has the supervision they want.

This year's program leaders are:

Brendan Lawlor: Brendan wants to live in a world where music and art programs never suffer from budget cuts, young children learn to play with circuits and code creatively, and our future generations are free from evil robot overlords. - 1. This **free** program is designed and offered for Middle School students ONLY.
- 2. Monday Friday from 3:00 5:15 (based on the school calendar/open days).
- 3. Students MUST hand in a parent or guardian-signed permission slip to attend.
- 4. Program will be supervised by a minimum of 2 adult NTWC staff.
- 5. Computers will be on hand for students to do homework and games.
- 6. Homework help will be offered, as well as socializing and activities that promote communication, teamwork, awareness and fun.
- 7. Snacks are available (please inform NTWC of any allergies)
- 8. Students are responsible to sign in and out every day of attendance.
- 9. Students are expected to be respectful toward other students, staff, and the space.
- 10. Students will clean up after themselves.
- 11. No fighting, bullying or foul language is acceptable.
