Fayette County Commissioner Angela Zimmerlink has announced an Organizational Meeting of the Marcellus Shale Taskforce-Fayette County.

The meeting is open to the general public, as well as, individuals representing the natural gas industry, environment, public safety, educators, business interests, elected officials and to anyone interested in either joining the taskforce or simply wishing to attend.

The meeting will be on Tuesday July 20<sup>th</sup> at 6pm at the offices of the Penn State Cooperative Extension which is located at 34 West Peter Street in Uniontown. The building is known as the Federal Building and is located next to CVS Pharmacy.

Zimmerlink said “after a power point presentation about the taskforce there will be break-out sessions of each subcommittee”  
The taskforce subcommittees will focus on eight areas: workforce, public safety, economic development, environment, planning, community impacts, public awareness and legislation.

Zimmerlink said “it has only been about three weeks since I announced the formation of this taskforce reaching out to the public and entities to participate as best I could and it will take people who are truly interested in Fayette County to help make this Marcellus Shale Taskforce an effective community tool”.
