FUNSHOOT FIND OUT MORE Our FunShoots have morphed into a falling steel type shoot. They are designed for almost any shooter, from the novice to the experienced multigunner. Primary guns are pistols and pistol caliber carbines. Yes, .22's are allowed! This is a casual, freeform shoot requiring little movement, timers or scoring. Our primary mission is to provide a venue to introduce yourself, your friends and kids to shooting. We are very family friendly!

22 RIMFIRE FIND OUT MORE Our next 22 Rimfire precision match is Sunday July 26th. These matches are meant to mimic their big brother, the Centerfire Long Range Precision match. The RPM consists of 6-8 stages and usually 60-100 rounds required to shoot the match. We incorporate different shooting positions and props in order to make a challenging course of fire that requires efficiently getting into position and engaging targets anywhere from 5-200 vards within 30-90 seconds

RIFLE FIND OUT MORE We offer a 100 yard and a 200 yard Rifle Range as well as one 50 yard pit and a short range pistol area.

EGG SHOOTS FIND OUT MORE Our next Egg Shoot is scheduled for Septem-

ber 6th. These are a 22lr only shooting sport that is not terribly complicated, but still challenging. The targets are typically 40 steel targets shaped like eggs and the size of an actual chicken egg. We shoot them in banks of 10 eggs at 10, 15, 20 and 25 yards with rifles, and/or 7,9,11,and 13 yards with pistols. There is no real time limit, but they are shot standing with no support, and you may only use one round per egg. No experience is necessary, but pre-registration is required.

Sunday June 7th, 7 1/2 out of the 38 folks on the "I'm interested to help out" mailing list showed up to drain/clean the raceway, filter boxes and screens (hat tip to the guy who showed up and gave us the half hour of honest effort he had that morning). We put in about 5 hours and failed to complete the mission. The raceway is open, and all fish are out. The screens were pulled and rinsed down. We then struggled with the sluiceway door that was supposed to cut off the water to the system. We found a design flaw and work finally stopped. We were all very tired and getting grumpy.

We will be regrouping on July 26th, 9 am, when we will pull the dam and modify the door system. The facility still needs more repair, and this will be assessed then.

By then Bob Nelson and Jerry Lauer will be leading the group. Cindy and I are standing down. With the help of a great crew, we spent the last two years rescuing this program, besieged with poorly maintained facilities and a bad reputation. Without the incredible record keeping of past trout Czar Duane Kornbaugh, the task would have been overwhelming. We learned more about raising trout than we ever imagined and worked with some wonderful club members, PAFB staff and renewed friendships with local co-ops.



Unfortunately, the issues we had this spring with the public just wiped us out, and it is not fun anymore. We will maintain an advisory role until Bob and Jerry are comfortable with the behind the scenes part of this program. Please, get involved. This is a worthy project and can be a lot of fun!
