

QuarkSoft-USA Contract Vehicle Descriptions:

USSOCOM SWMS A- The SOCOM Wide Mission Support (SWMS) Group A contract vehicle provides any and all USSOCOM Headquarters, organizations, Components, JSOC, and TSOCs to obtain services support in for global Special Operations Forces (SOF). SWMS will provide USSOCOM with a variety of services in the following Knowledge Based Services portfolios: Program Management, Engineering & Technical and Professional Services. The SWMS Group A maximum amount is \$900M total over all prime contracts over an ordering period from 2 June 2016 through 28 July 2020.

US Army Aviation and Missile Command (AMCOM) Expedited Professional and Engineering Support Services (Express) – The AMCOM EXPRESS contract is a multiple award BPA program leveraging GSA schedules to provide comprehensive advisory and assistance services to the AMCOM Life Cycle Management Command, U.S. Army Program Executive Offices (PEOs), U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC), U.S. Army Research, Development and Engineering Command (RDECOM) and other customers.

US Air Force NETCENTS – The Network-Centric Solutions-2 (NETCENTS-2) contracts provide the Air Force with a primary source of netcentric and IT products, services, and solutions. Use of the NETCENTS-2 contracts (except ITPS) is mandatory for Air Force organizations as the contracts are awarded.

GSA Alliant (SB) - Alliant Small Business, GSA's premier small business set-aside GWAC, provides flexible access to customized IT solutions from a large, diverse pool of industry partners. With a \$15 billion program ceiling and a five-year base period with one five-year option, Alliant Small Business allows for long-term planning of large-scale program requirements, while strengthening opportunities for small businesses.

GSA Mission Oriented Business Integrated Services (MOBIS) - The MOBIS program offers a full range of management and consulting services that can improve a federal agency's performance, and their endeavors to meet their mission goals.

NIH CIO-SP3 - Cutting-edge technology. A large and diverse pool of proven industry leaders. Streamlined acquisition and fast provisioning. These are among the advantages of choosing CIO-SP3, a new Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) from NITAAC that can be used by any federal civilian or DoD agency to fulfill a broad range of mission critical IT requirements. With a \$20 billion ceiling, flexible contract types and the ability to award in modular increments and incorporate performance-based features, CIO-SP3 allows for streamlined planning, acquisition and deployment of large-scale IT program requirements.

GSA Schedule 70 - IT Schedule 70 is the largest, most widely used acquisition vehicle in the federal government. Schedule 70 is an indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (IDIQ) multiple award schedule, providing direct access to products, services and solutions from more than 5,000 certified industry partners. The IT Schedule 70 provides a wide variety of products and services which allows contractor team arrangements allowing collaboration. Some of the services are Cloud IT Services, Computer and Networking Hardware, Cyber Security, Data Center and Storage, Telecommunications, and Software and Applications.

The Department of Veterans Affairs Transformation Twenty-One Total Technology (VA T4) is a five-year indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract covering the full range of IT services and support. Transformation Twenty-One Total Technology (T4) is not intended as a mechanism to solely purchase IT products. Such products may be purchased to the extent that those products are necessary to deliver the solution required.
