BAPTISM STIPEND - \$25.00 - Baptisms are celebrated by appointment (after a Baptism Preparation Course has been completed).

BAPTISM PREPARATION: The baptism of a child is a very important event in the life of the child, the child's family, and the parish community. To help parents enter more fully into the celebration of their child's baptism, St. Joseph's Parish offers a Baptism Preparation Course by appointment. Parents along with godparents are expected to attend the Baptism Preparation Course before the baptism of the child. Please call the Parish Office to register.

MARRIAGE STIPEND - \$200.00 - Please allow at least six months between the time of contacting the Parish and the date of the Marriage. A Marriage Preparation Course is required.

FUNERAL STIPEND - \$200.00 - St. Joseph's Parish has a Bereavement Committee which will contact you to coordinate the funeral services.

CATECHESIS

AUGUST 22 - MEMORIAL OF THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: In 1954, Pope Pius XII instituted this memorial "so that all may clearly recognize and more zealously venerate the kind and maternal rule of the Mother of God" (*Ad Caeli Reginam*). This memorial is celebrated on the Octave of the Solemnity of the Assumption.

AUGUST 23 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT ROSE OF LIMA, VIRGIN: Rose was born in 1586 in Lima, Peru. While still young, she chose for herself a life of prayer and penance, subjecting her body to austerities as well as deprivation of food and sleep. As a result, she endured interior periods of darkness and desolation as well as mystical experiences. She joined the Third Order of St. Dominic and lived in a little hut in her parents' garden, working to help support them. She died in 1617 at age 31, and in 1671 she became the first canonized saint of the New World.

AUGUST 24 - FEAST OF SAINT BARTHOLOMEW, APOSTLE: Bartholomew left everything to follow Jesus, becoming his disciple, his intimate friend, and an apostle entrusted with the continuation of Christ's mission. The Gospels of Saints Matthew, Mark and Luke, as well as the Acts of the Apostles, count Bartholomew as one of the twelve apostles.

AUGUST 25 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT JOSEPH CALASANZ, PRIEST: Joseph, often referred to by his Latin name, Calasanctius, was born in Spain. He was ordained at age 28 and became aware of the plight of poor children and their need for education. When he could not get permission for them to attend regular schools, he used his inheritance to set up free schools for the poor. He died in 1648, was canonized in 1767, and is a patron of schools which serve the needs of poor children.

AUGUST 25 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT LOUIS: As King of France, Louis IX proved to be a man of justice, mercy, peace, and great piety. Gothic architecture flourished during his reign, particularly in the building of chapels and great cathedrals. During his 44-year reign, Louis gained for his people an era of unprecedented peace and prosperity. Louis, known as a saintly king, was canonized in 1297. He is a patron of masons and sculptors.

AUGUST 27 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT MONICA: Monica was the mother of Saint Augustine, and all we know about her comes from Saint Augustine's spiritual autobiography entitled *Confessions*. Her religious influence was so great that both her husband and mother-in-law converted to Christianity. She is largely known for devoting herself in prayer for the conversion of Augustine who had abandoned his Christian faith. Her prayers were answered and Augustine returned to his faith. Monica is a patron of mothers.
