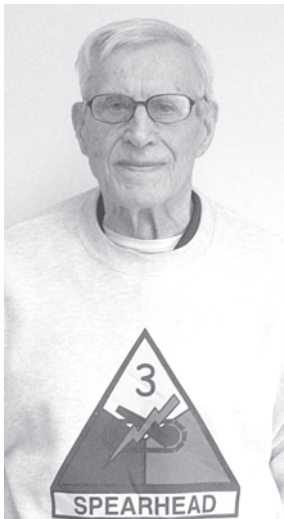
Technology and Me

Join North Shore Area Partners and the Lighthouse Center for Vision Loss for the second in a series of three presentations, entitled "Technology and Me", on Tuesday, March 26, at 1:00 p.m. at the Lake County Service Center, Silver Bay, Room 23. The focus of this presentation is for individuals 55 and older and their family members, but is not limited to those who have vision loss. All ages and abilities are welcome.
