I love May! Particularly this year – May 2018!

I am writing this letter on Friday morning, April 20. The sun is shining, the temperatures remain in the high 20's but the forecast is into the 50's by Sunday, and the snow that is melting away is glistening like beautiful crystal sparkles --- it's a day full of good prospects and May (one of my favorite months) is just around the corner!

Why is May so special and remarkable?

Of course, there is the expected bursting forth of spring flowers!

AND there is the traditional celebration of Mother's Day and Memorial Day...both commemorating the significant contributions and love of our mothers and the precious lives of our loved ones who have passed from this world to the next. The MOTHER'S DAY BRUNCH on May 12 is always a GRAND CELEBRATION!

ALSO at SHUMC --- we'll be celebrating the WELCOME of another NEW MEMBERSHIP CLASS AND then on **Saturday evening**,

May 19, we'll be enjoying a CHURCH FAMILY Fun Night in the fellowship hall for a first ever "TRIVIA NIGHT" designed for the fun of our entire church family and to raise money for CAMPERSHIPS to help send every one of our children to 'church camp'.

AND, another VERY REMARKABLE celebration occurring in May --- is my birthday!

BUT ---- EVEN MORE than all of these REMARKABLE celebrations & recognitions --- this year --- we'll be celebrating **ASCENSION SUNDAY and PENTECOST** !!!!

Officially, **ASCENSION DAY** is Thursday, May 10 (always 40 days after Easter). We'll preach about ASCENSION DAY on April 22 BUT THEN RECOGNIZE IT AGAIN on the official date of ASCENSION SUNDAY, on May 13. ASCENSION DAY celebrates the earthly life of Christ AND the commissioning of the disciples to GO AND BE WITNESSES OF JESUS CHRIST and TO WORK DILIGENTLY, AS THE CHURCH, TO PREPARE ONE ANOTHER AND THE WORLD FOR THE PROMISED "SECOND COMING" OF JESUS!

THEN – 10 days later (50 days after Easter) we'll be recognizing the CELEBRATION OF **PENTECOST** ... for us, as New Testament Christians, this is a most REMARKABLE & special day ... a day that we celebrate the **GIFT OF GOD's SPIRIT**, the HOLY SPIRIT, COMING UPON ALL WHO BELIEVE. With the commitment to be a Christian believer also comes the responsibility and the privilege TO SHARE and TO BE A PART OF GOD's REDEEMING AND RESTORING WORK --- to help prepare the world for Jesus' 2nd coming!

PENTECOST was an Old Testament Feast known as the HOLY FEAST OF THE WEEKS, which later included "PENTECOST" as a way to commemorate God's gift of the 10 Commandments at Mount Sinai as well as God's gift of the first harvest of the season. It was set to occur exactly 7 weeks or 50 days after PASSOVER.

Isn't it cool that God would pick this established and remarkable Jewish holiday celebrating God's gifts to the world to also recognize God's gift of the Holy Spirit to every Christian believer.

I encourage each of us, as Christians, and as a part of the SHUMC family ... to add readings, thoughts and reflections upon the significance of: 1) THE LIFE & WORK OF CHRIST; 2) Christ's COMMISSIONING OF ALL BELIEVERS TO BE CREDIBLE WITNESSES to the life & ministry JESUS; and 3) the WONDER, POWER, PRESENCE, PEACE and PROMISE of the HOLY SPIRIT UPON US, IN US AND THROUGH US.

Truly, I am looking forward to preaching and teaching from the Book of Acts this month as we ask God to open our lives and our church to the REMARKABLE PRESENCE AND WORK OF GOD's HOLY SPIRIT --- IMAGINE --- WE ARE able to know and experience God, thru the Holy Spirit upon us just as the 1st century Christian believers! ... and may our world be forever CHANGED AND IMPACTED as was theirs in the 1st century!

I pray that each of us may realize and experience this HOLY PRESENCE of GOD in OUR LIVES IN A NEW WAY THIS MONTH ...

MAY 2018 is indeed a most REMARKABLE MONTH!

Everyone is welcome, and we mean everyone. Grab your friends, neighbors, strangers (they'll soon be friends) and people walking down the street.


The event is free but we are hoping to raise money for camperships.

Thank you for your help. Let's fill our tables with treasures.




Save the Date: June 10th, 2018


