Regular Membership Requirements

To become a member of the MFCMC, you must have served in the U.S. Armed Forces, a local, state, or federal Law Enforcement agency or a Fire/Rescue agency. You must have and maintain a concealed weapons permit, and own or ride a touring or cruiser style motorcycle.

Civilian Patriot Requirements

You must be a United States Citizen, served in a support capacity to the U.S. Armed Forces, Fire Rescue, and Law Enforcement in America, or be sponsored by a regular MFC MC member. You must also have and maintain a concealed weapons permit, and own or ride a touring or cruiser style motorcycle.

Associate Requirements

U.S. Citizen who supports the mission of the MFC and its Membership.
