

3CMeNow Desktop Controls – for iPhone, iPad and iTouch iOS Platform Conference and Presentation Modes

The Conference Mode (camera button) Presentation Mode (monitor button) is shown at the bottom of the screen when you connect to your meeting.

The purpose of the steps outlined below is to show you how to configure your PowerPoint® slide show to display full screen in your moderator window, and still allow you to see the participants list, chat and moderator controls in your main monitor display



- Turn your deice side ways to make the participants picture bigger
 - Conference Mode enables you to see all of the participants
 - Your Meeting is in Conference Mode by default






- Presentation Mode enables you to see whatever the moderator is showing like a PowerPoint presentation.
- The white number in the red circle next to the Presentation Monitor button shows how many different (not new) slides the presenter has shown since the last time you were in Presentation Mode.
- This number will clear and start over again after you enter and exit Presentation Mode
- Press the Presentation button to enter Presentation Mode

- 3. You will want to turn your device sideways if your slides or other presentation are 16x9
- 4. Swipe from right to left to advance your slides.
 - The Replay message in the upper left corner indicates a slide that has been used by the presenter while you are currently in Presentation Mode.
 - The Live message in the upper left corner indicates the slide the presenter is currently using during while you are currently in Presentation Mode.
