DID YOU KNOW....

the OCNA Board works all through the summer for you?

We meet with City officials and developers to express the concerns of our neighbors on traffic, parking, safety, homelessness, and balanced growth.

Recently, the Board, with paid membership approval, voted to support continuing Measure X - ½ cent sales tax everyone has been paying since 2019. This applies to both residents & tourists.

Our neighborhoods have and will receive numerous benefits:

- Additional EMT's to decrease response time for citizens in need.
- Neighborhood patrols of our streets & alleys by Gatekeepers Security service.
- Additional Crime Suppression personnel and cameras in key areas.
- Youth programming for crime and gang diversion opportunities.
- Additional Homeless Outreach Team (HOT) staff including a social worker.
- An additional \$1 Million for fixing our roads, faster then would be budgeted.
- A new fire station downtown that will accommodate taller ladder trucks.
- New traffic calming measures in our neighborhood; stop signs & red curbs.
- South strand rehabilitation study and repairs to the on-going ocean erosion.
- Beaches & beach parks improvements
- El Corazon park Site 1 and Buccaneer Park improvements.
- Funding the pier base rehabilitation required due to its nearly 100 yr age.

RE-BEACH EFFORTS THIS SUMMER:

The City's Coastal Management conducted a beach update and survey on the proposed "speed bumps" location along the south of the Pier Strand. This workshop was conducted electronically to allow more people to participate. The location survey result is expected to be released early fall. Support groups have also been successful in getting on-going City funding for beach sand and habitat maintenance!
