

# **Hopkinton Lions / Hopkinton Fire Department**

## **Golf Ball Drop Fundraiser Rules**

**Purpose:** To provide an enjoyable outing for the Hopkinton Community, and to raise money for the Hopkinton Lions Club, for use in funding Lions Charities and supporting Lions Community Outreach Events

**Description:** A collection of uniquely numbered golf balls, purchased by contestants, will be dropped from the top of a fire truck ladder, onto a field where a golf pin has been placed. Prizes will be awarded to the owner of golf balls, as a result of their position relative to the pin. (see below). A maximum of 500 tickets will be sold for the event.

**Date / time / location:** June 26, 2:00, HHS field #10 (along the loop road); Rain date June 27.

**Eligibility:** Tickets may be purchased by anyone over the age of 18. Members of Lions Clubs and Hopkinton Fire Department are also eligible to participate, along with the general public.

**Prizes:** First place, closest to the pin: \$350; second place, farthest from the pin: \$100. In the event of ties for first place, the \$350 will be divided among those tied for closest; in the event of ties for farthest from the pin, the \$100 will be divided among those tied for farthest. Winners of more than \$250 will be mentioned on the Raffle paperwork filed with the state.

### **How to enter / purchase tickets:**

In person, from a Hopkinton Lion selling tickets, payment by cash or check (to "Hopkinton Lions Club"):

On-line, via PayPal, fill out the online form ([www.hopkintonlions.org/rafflepurchase.html](http://www.hopkintonlions.org/rafflepurchase.html)) with the amount of tickets purchased, along with your email address; you will receive a return email within 24 hours, indicating acceptance of your purchase, and notifying you of the numbered ball(s) purchased. Please retain this email to claim your prize if you are one of the winners.

**The contest:** On the day of the event:

- The Lions will attempt to capture the event on video, and later post to the website, covering: the balls used, the ball drop from the fire truck ladder, and the determination of the closest/farthest balls.
- Spectators are welcome at the event, subject to any existing COVID guidelines in place in Hopkinton at the time.
- The winning ball(s) and the names of the winners will be posted on the Lions website, shortly after the event is completed.
- The winners will be contacted by email and/or phone. The winners need to provide their Paypal email reply or in-person receipt to collect.
