12 BASIC STEPS OF BOW TUNING

- 1. Pick the proper arrow.
- 2. Select the proper rest for your style of shooting.
- 3. Adjust the bow for an even tiller.
- 4. Adjust the draw length.
- 5. Time the cam(s) and mark them for future reference.
- 6. Adjust the nock height.
- 7. Adjust the center shot for the arrow rest.
- 8. Set the peep sight for the proper height.
- 9. Perform a powder test for vane clearance.
- 10. Paper tune the bow from two different distances (or bare shaft tune if finger shooter).
- 11. Group tune the arrows by adjusting the tiller.
- 12. Record all measurements for future reference.
