Adult Basic Education (ABE)

Adult Basic Education provides instruction in Math, Reading, and Writing in preparation for the GED® test or entry into the James H. Groves Adult High School.

English As A Second Language (ESL) Programs

English as a Second Language programs improve adults who want to learn English to obtain a job, help their children in school, enter into post secondary training or college, and be more active in their communities.

GED® Test Preparation

Learn the skills needed to pass the GED® test. The GED® certification is a secondary endorsement recognized by employers, colleges and vocational skills training programs.

Family Literacy

This program focuses on families learning together. Parents receive academic instruction towards their GED® or Groves High School Diploma and participate in parenting classes while their children receive reading readiness instruction or help with school work.

Enrolling in ABE

(All participants must be at least 16 years of age and formally withdrawn from the K-12 educational systems.)

- You will be tested in Math, Reading and Writing to determine your strengths and weaknesses.
- You will be placed only in the classes that meet your individual needs.
- Get ready to obtain your dream of a GED® or high school diploma.
