

#### Pastor's Paragraphs. . .

I recently read a wonderful article titled: "10 Traits of a Great Church Member," by Ron Edmondson. I wanted to share some of his ideas with you. He acknowledges that God is the one who builds the church. However, God uses people to build it. The article then lists ten characteristics of Great Church Members, who will help build a Great Church.

#### **Great church members:**

#### 1) Believe and love God's Word.

Joshua 1:8 – "Study this Book of the Law continually. Meditate on it day and night so you may be sure to obey all that is written in it. Only then will you succeed." Great church members read and study the Bible, letting it guide them and the church.

#### 2) Grow in prayer.

Ephesians 6:18 – "Pray at all times and on every occasion in the power of the Holy Spirit. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all Christians everywhere." Great church members pray more than worry.

#### 3) Build on faith.

Hebrews 10:38 – "And a righteous person will live by faith."

Great church members are willing to walk by faith as God leads, even through the most challenging times.

#### 4) Put God's will first.

Mark 3:35 – "Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother." Great church members seek what God wants above all else, not pursuing their own hopes and dreams, but God's will above all.

#### 5) Enjoy meeting with God regularly.

Amos 4:12 – "Prepare to meet your God,"

Great church members look expectantly and often for opportunities to worship God and experience Him with other believers, and by themselves.

#### 6) Support the pastor and the church.

1 Corinthians 16:10-11 – "When Timothy comes, treat him with respect. He is doing the Lord's work, just as I am. Don't let anyone despise him."

Your next pastor won't be perfect. S/he will have gifts and weaknesses, passions and pains. Look for ways to encourage your pastor. Above all, pray for your pastor.

#### 7) Encourage others in the church.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 – "So encourage each other and build each other up, just as you are already doing." Great church members are a part of the solution, not a part of the problem. They look for ways to help, rather than complain. They volunteer and use their gifts to build the church.

#### 8) Don't think everything is about them!

Matthew 16:24 – "Then Jesus said to the disciples, 'If any of you wants to be my follower, you must put aside your selfish ambition, shoulder your cross, and follow me."

Did you know everything may not go your way? Great church members are willing to allow the best to be done for the church even when it sometimes goes against their personal desires.

#### 9) Think outside the walls of the church.

Acts 1:8 – "But when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, you will receive power and will tell people about me everywhere--in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Church is not just what happens inside the church building. The days of hoping people will come find us are long gone. Great church members think of those not yet in a church...and support the church in reaching them. The church must go out, and share God's love with the world.

#### 10) Maintain a friendly church.

2 John 6 – "Love means doing what God has commanded us, and he has commanded us to love one another, just as you heard from the beginning."

Great church members make sure guests never stand around long with no one to talk to. They are welcoming and friendly to everyone, with or without a title to do so.

I'm so thankful to be in a church with so many who make this list easy to write. What would you add to this list?

Trusting that we all want Puckety to be a Great Church, I invite you to make it that way by becoming a Great Member.

# Redstone Stories

## **Mission Partners**

Even though Trinity Church in New Florence and Third Presbyterian Church in Uniontown are over 60 miles apart, the two churches have partnered for mission trips for the past four years. The churches are very different. Trinity is rural. Third is in a small city. Trinity has under 100 members and Third has over 200. Yet the two congregations have worked together to rebuild homes and lives from New Jersey to Houston to the Carolinas.



Marilyn Fitzsimmons, an elder at Third has a passion for planning mission trips that bring the churches together and also include students from local colleges like Penn State (Fayette), Clarion, Pitt and Robert Morris.

"Our goal is to unite together with other people and denominations," Fitzsimmons says. "We love having students join us because they are young and energetic."

She says that the mission partnership between the two congregations has worked well.

"We have some people who are really skilled and when they get their heads together they can do anything," she says.

Bill Betz of Trinity the mission partnership has brought the congregation together in new ways. The older folks often have the finances to support mission but not the energy to do the work of mission. The younger people have the energy, but not always the money. Working together, they are able to reach out and help others in Jesus' name. Betz says going on mission trips has helped him to get a new perspective on his life and faith.

"I have way too many things. Material things used to be important. But, once you go on one of these trips and see what people don't have it makes you rethink what it is you 'need.' The congregation has seen that change in me and it's helped them to be more generous about mission."

Fitzsimmons and Betz both welcome anyone who is interested to join their mission work by calling the church. Trinity also has a mission Facebook page at facebook.com/thelightmissionteam/
