

So what is a "continuous drive" anyway?

Perhaps your new years resolution include getting your critter out more or trying new things. If so the upcoming "continuous drive" may be just the thing to help you check off your list!

Coming soon, CVHA will be holding a continuous drive at Fresno Horse Park (formerly RamTap). This event contains "lite" versions of all the elements of a CDE: shortened pace drives with obstacles, a dressage test, and a cones course, all driven back to back over about an hour.

It is the perfect introductory event for drivers without experience and for equines with low fitness levels. The format can vary somewhat, so it is important to read the event information carefully. Official ADS rules for this format can be found in Chapter 13 of the rule book, although many events of this type, *including this upcoming one*, are not recognized events and so have house rules specified. For instance, while a helmet and whip are required at the CVHA event, aprons and formal attire are not. ... *continued on page 3*.

...continued from page 1: "So what is a 'continuous drive' anyway?"

The weekend opens with arrivals on Friday and driving on the grounds; just don't drive on the actual course. All courses are open for inspection on foot. Saturday consists of two sessions: half the participants drive the course in the morning while the other half staff the show, and then everyone switches roles in the afternoon. **On Sunday, we repeat the event, this time just for fun!** No awards are given Sunday, but it is fun to see if you can better your score from Saturday.

No experience is necessary as we will teach you what you need to know to drive and to help run the show. Extra volunteers are always appreciated, so bring your friends or come along without a critter and enjoy a fun day.

The course will open with a safety check to make sure everyone has a safe start. Once cleared, the start of Section A is just up the road. A track of about 2K with two obstacles makes up this first section. There are spotters at each obstacle to verify that the correct path is taken, but only the total time is recorded for the section. The goal is to maintain the proper pace to complete the track within a time window. After a brief break, the dressage field awaits. Participants drive their test and then head back to the pace field for a second track of about 2K and two more obstacles. Lastly, it's back across the way to the cones field where a course of about 20 cones awaits.




