(food for thought) Gospel: Mark 9: 38-43, 47-48.

One of the hardest things to overcome in human nature is the tendency to categorize people between those who are "in" and those who are "out." We all want to be accepted by our own inner circle of family and friends, and exclusion by contemporaries can be painful and even damaging. People derive a sense of self worth and a way of exerting power over others by belonging to a group that, in their own eyes, seems to be better than others. To maintain acceptance we may even keep silent when we should object to unkind behavior or conversation by our peers.

The need to belong to the inner circles can be found in all age groups, cultures, religions, nationalities, races and in both genders. It can be the source of peer-pressure, bullying, partisanship and polarization. And it can lead to the self-inflicted wound of blinding oneself to the larger picture, the broader outlook, the more hopeful vision...

The first reading and the Gospel cause us to examine our own attitudes.

As followers of Christ, we are in a "process of becoming." Even though we may have already given our commitment to follow Christ, there are times in our lives when we are asked to make choices that put our discipleship on the line. Some options require us to reject what seems like the attractive or easier ways of acting. These choices may force us to think "outside the box," to be more forgiving, more reconciling, more open. These choices may put us at odds with family, friends or our surrounding culture; but we know we must choose in ways that echo the good news that we believe.
