



COVID-19 PREVENTION AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

To continue to be able to do our part to help keep Antietam Creek and Conococheague Creek Watersheds healthy and safe, we must be healthy and safe ourselves. With this in mind, the following Covid-19 Prevention and Safety Guidelines will be in effect at all ACWA events until further notice. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

1. Each person who wants to volunteer will need to register separately. We will not be able to take unregistered volunteers (including children, friends, co-workers).
2. If anyone who has registered experiences any of the following within 10 days prior to the event, please stay home so that we can keep everyone safe.
 - a. Fever or feeling feverish
 - b. Shortness of breath, difficulty breathing
 - c. Pain or pressure in your chest
 - d. Cough or flu-like symptoms
 - e. Loss of taste or smell
 - f. Been around anyone who has tested positive or experience symptoms
3. Volunteers will practice social distancing by staying at least 6 feet away from other participants that are not from their own household
4. Masks or face coverings are required of ALL participants. If you need to remove your mask to drink or eat, please adhere to social distancing requirements.
5. If a volunteer refuses to wear a mask/face covering or adhere to social distancing guidelines, they will be asked to leave.
6. We will provide hand sanitizer and limited event supplies (trash bags, reusable gloves that will be sterilized after use). Participants should bring any additional supplies they may want (trash grabbers, etc.)
7. Participants need to bring their own water snacks as we are unable to supply these at this time.
8. If you experience symptoms or are diagnosed with Covid-19 within 10 days PRIOR to the event, please do not attend.
9. If you experience symptoms or are diagnosed with Covid-19 within 10 days AFTER the event, please let us know.
