October 12, 2017 MCCPTA Delegates and Presidents

Earlier this week, as your MCCPTA VP of Educational Issues, I provided testimony at the Board of Education (BOE) Meeting during the Public Comment period. On behalf of the MCCPTA Board of Directors, we've asked the Superintendent and BOE to help MCCPTA leadership understand the growing practice of eliminating on-level options in our middle and high schools. We want to ensure all students have appropriate pathways and trajectories to follow into their post-secondary destination.

While these school-specific decisions to eliminate course offerings are, no doubt, being made with the best of intentions, we are concerned about the unintended consequences of narrowing student options and we've asked the Superintendent and Board of Education to help MCCPTA in creating more transparency surrounding the methodology and data that are driving these decisions.
