Be sure to include a copy of your high school transcript with your application. This transcript should include ACT and/or SAT scores, class rank and GPA. Also list any scholarships you have received or will receive.

Letters of recommendations: Obtain **TWO** letters of recommendation supporting your scholarship application. One letter must be from a high school teacher who is aware of the quality of your work. The other letter should be from someone who knows you personally, such as a neighbor, employer or clergy person who can address issues of good character and good citizenship.
