

Hello everyone! A bit of a long post but an important one!

REOPENING!

As you will be aware the Govt. have decided that amongst other businesses; the Pub will be allowed to open! Hurrah!! We are intending to open on the 4th July for both lunch and dinner services and Sunday 5th July lunch.

With this in mind our way of business will be a little different and we will be creating our own guidelines for the safety of our staff and customers.

We will be opening the side garden and the front terrace to start with. The top garden will be closed as will the inside of the Pub for the time being. The shape of the pub is not conducive to the requirements of social distancing.

We will be operating our garden similar to the takeaway, on going, and we will require you to preorder your food and drinks as much in advance as possible. Adhering to the requirement of "Track and Trace" we are required to retain information of those attending the pub and will do so merely by taking, and retaining for 21 days, your name and phone number on reservation or booking. This will be a paper record, not electronic, and will be destroyed after the appropriate time has lapsed.

If you would like to eat in the garden you will need to let us know at the time of booking; this must be booked in advance. If you are just coming to drink (in groups of no more than x6 people from separate households) we will still need to know in advance. There will be limited space while this rotten Covid-19 hangs around.

Please, please do not turn up unannounced and with no booking as it is quite possible that you will be turned away and we would like to avoid any opportunity of embarrassment, alienation or cross words! As the guidance on behaviour has been somewhat wishy-washy we have had to create our own rules of engagement. Whilst we are now being allowed to serve you beer and food the Pub is not yet back! We will do our utmost to make you welcome but that can only be achieved by adherence to our rules.

We will have designated tables for people just wanting to drink and tables that are designated for food. We will be providing food in our compostable takeaway containers so if you want plates or cutlery and to dine in an alfresco picnic style you must bring your own. For people drinking please also bring your own glasses. We will provide plastic glasses (not very eco but safe). Bins will be available in the garden to dispose of your rubbish after you have finished. This is to avoid as much cross contamination as reasonably possible. We will also be providing hand sanitizer at the collection door and on every table we ask that you use this upon arrival and when taking your seat.

We are constructing composting toilets in the rear car park to aid in your well being as we still will not be allowing the general public into the building.

We will also unfortunately not be allowing anyone under the age of 11 in the garden for the time being until social distancing is gone. We do not want to have to be policing children as well as adults!

Anyone requiring Oysters or Lobster etc for the weekend please let me know as soon as!

Bookings must be made over the phone; we will not accept booking made via any other contact.
