 - A.) "shod" Greek=hupodeo *hoop-od-eh'-o* to bind under ones feet; put on shoes or sandals, bind on.
 - B.) How do we "tie" on this gospel of peace?
 - 1.) We must know the "Good News". I cor 15:1-11
- C.) If we keep the gospel bound tight we will not fall or loose our way! Psalm 119:105
- II.) The Shield of Faith eph 6:16
 - A.) Faith is the number one defensive weapon of the five pieces of armor. "Above all...)
 - B.) The shield is not tied on or worn it is carried, you have to hold on to your faith. I Tim 1:18-19
 - C.) We must trust in the Lord. If we hold onto our faith, he will deliver us. Hebrews 4:14-16
- III.) Helmet of salvation eph. 6:17a
 - A.) Protects your mind. The place where the wisdom of God is stored, and the place where the seed of doubt is planted. James 1:5-8
 - B.) We can have confidence in the lord to deliver us. Psalm 33:17-22
