Shop Tour

Take route 16 West thru Zullinger, turn right on Waynecastle Road. Then right on Five Forks Road. Take Five Forks Road till you pass a small church on the right. You will see a Private Drive Sign, Turn Left. We are the third house back.

From Greencastle:

Take route 16 East till you come to an underpass, turn left immediately after going thru the underpass. (Waynecastle Road). Continue on Waynecastle Road to the second road to the left (Five Forks Road). Continue on Five Forks Road till you pass a small church on right. You will see a Private Drive Sign. Turn Left. We are the third house back.

From Chambersburg:

Take route 316 South to Five Forks, turn right onto Five Forks Road (across bridge) Stay to the left of the Y. Continue on Five Forks Road (8 tenths of a mile), you will see a Caution 2 hidden entrance sign. Then a Private Drive Sign.

Turn Right at the Private Drive Sign. We are the third house back.
