

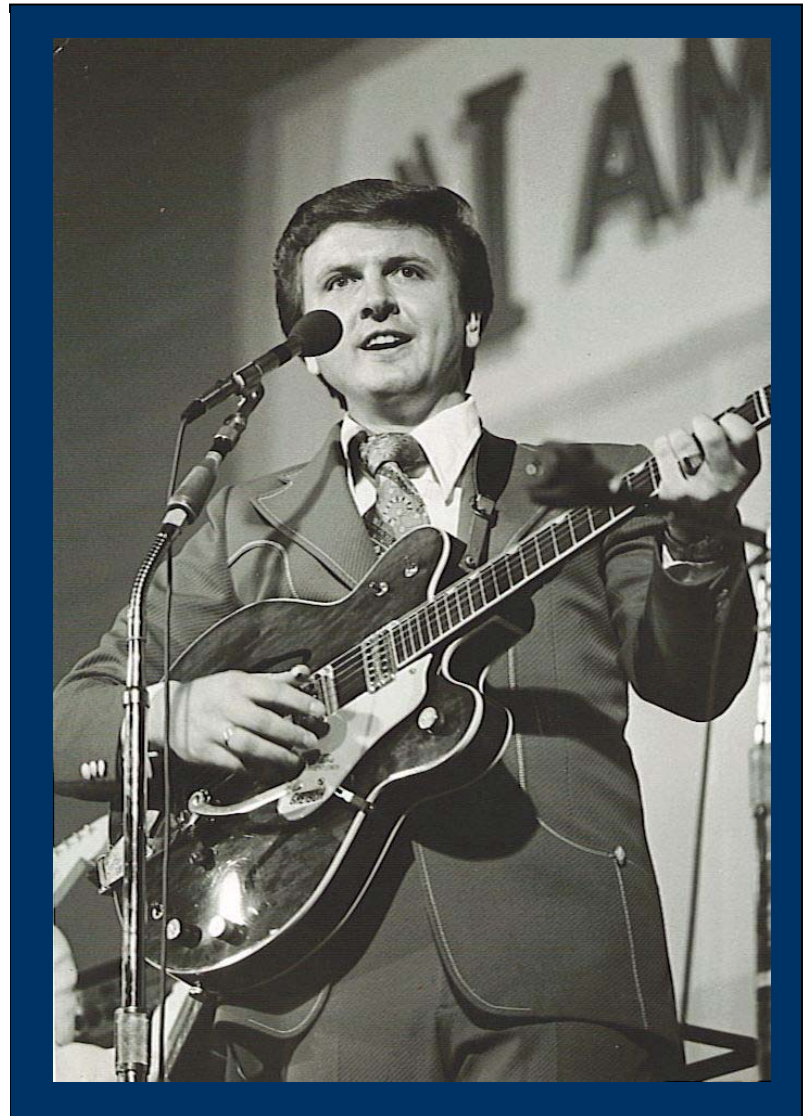
Minnesota Music Hall of Fame Inductee

When Lowell was in the eighth grade he asked his Dad to teach him to play guitar. At 13 he sat in with dance bands playing for free just so he could learn. At 14 he started his own country band but began playing rock & roll when it was popular. This lead to winning 2nd prize out of 92 contestants in a talent show. He was given a radio program on a local station and later he appeared on TV. When he met his wife, Connie and she sang gospel songs, it struck a place in Lowell's heart. Today they are
