

## CVRWF MEETING – April 17th

We are proud to present Rebecca Friedrichs, author of *Standing Up to Goliath: Battling State and National Teachers' Unions for the Heart and Soul of Our Kids and Country*, a powerful expose of state and national teachers' unions told through dozens of engaging personal accounts. Her lawsuit, Friedrichs vs California Teachers' Association, which sought to free teachers from forced unionism, was argued before the U.S. Supreme Court in 2016. Poised to rule 5-4 in Rebecca's favor, the court deadlocked after the death of Justice Antonin Scalia. She will speak to us about her lawsuit and expose the unbelievable power of the teachers' unions on Wednesday, April 17, 2019, at Marbella Country Club in San Juan Capistrano, CA.

As a twenty-eight year public school teacher, Rebecca was forced to fund state and national teachers' unions whose politics and divisive tactics degraded her profession, our schools and our national character. She's determined to stop state and national unions from destroying our schools

and American values, and won't give up. Her book and movement are the result of her ongoing battle to right the wrongs in our schools and culture. She's also founder and President of For Kids and Country, a national movement of parents, teachers, students, faith leaders and citizens uniting to restore our schools and culture.

## **LEGISLATION**

### **SAMPLES of the 2,000 CALIFORNIA BILLS**

#### **SOBER LIVING**

AB 704: Requires criminal background checks for employees

AB 1779: BEST PRACTICES. Denies certificates to operators who previously lost licenses. Sets standards for recovery before receiving state monies.

SB 283-AB 551: Regulates law to test for opioids and alcohol within 48 hours of a traffic fatality.

SB 116: Adds fentanyl to the dangerous drug list.

#### **HOMELESS**

SB 2: States that each community will monitor the homeless. At present, Prop 63 holds the county responsible.

#### **VOTING**

We need to contact our representatives demanding voter ID. There is rampant fraud of voter impersonation since SB 450 VOTER CHOICE ACT passed in 2016.

SB 401: Closes loopholes that allowed elected officials and candidates to avoid contribution limits. Also, the same limits would apply on ballot measures in order to avoid the influences of special interests.

#### **SOME GOOD AND SOME NOT**

AB 1317 - SB 2118: This allows renters and home ownership tax credit accounts.

AB 317: Stops DMV third party appointment selling.

AB 427: Exempts tax on military pay.

PROP 63: Referred to as SPLIT ROLL for commercial property to lose Proposition 13 protections and be taxed at a significantly higher level by 2020..

AB 502: License fee write offs for first year nurses and half fees for inactive licenses.

AB 147: Wayfair Tax for on- line business.

Saving the taxes on water testing, car batteries, tires, gas/oil from the earth and cell phones for another issue!!


